- We explained further about “What is a Cleft” & also shared our knowledge on management before & after cleft operations.
- We talked also about how CCFI manages patients with special needs, using a cleft patient that we have managed in the past as an example.

The audience was very enthusiastic to hear about CCFI & had expressed strong interest in joining CCFI for future Home Visit in their area.

The Vice Mayor of East Java – Mr. Saifulloh Yusuf was

also present at this talk. He thought it was very useful to spread the word about cleft so cleft patients in many villages can be located.

CCFI with the help of The Lions Club & midwife association, gave information about cleft and the services CCFI provide to cleft children. We look forward to future collaboration with other clubs in spreading the good work of CCFI.

# PATIENT'S STORY

## ZULFIKAR NASRULLOH

We first met him on 20-05-2009 (first home visit). Zulfikar was born on 7-5-2009 has unilateral cleft lip and palate, the weight: 3,6 kg, the height:49 cm and the head circ.36 cm, the child is healthy, financial condition is very poor. We always monitoring the child's condition until the surgery is done when the child 10 month. On 14-12-2009 the mother said that the child has been hospitalized since 11-12-2009 because of diarrhea the weight 7,1 kg, if the child get sick we always extra monitoring every day we monitoring because we want give a good service for his child, if the child is healthy we monitoring every 2 week. He got new surgery schedule on 15-4-2010. But once again he got sick (suspect Pulmonal Infection). He should under medication for 6 months.

Finally he can follow the cleft surgery on March 03, 2011.



## FEBILIA KHARISMA

We met Febilia on the first time when she was 4 months aged; she is baby girl who has bilateral cleft lip and palate. When we did the first home visit, her condition was very bad; her weight was only 4,4 kg (standard weight at 4 months is 5 kg) and she using feeding tube for the feeding. The mother told me that the pediatrician ask her to feed using feeding tube until the child is 10 months aged to prevent the child get choking, so the child never feed using nipple at all. We explain to the mother that the child should be stop to feed using feeding tube because the child need to suck nipple to exercise her mouth muscle, otherwise the child will get problem when she need to start eat semi solid food and when the child star to speak. We show to her the proper position during feeding.

Finally, after long medication, the child can be recovered from the infection and she get lip and palate repair on 20/02/2011 (when the child is 1 year aged).

### How we assist during a mass operation



Between March and June there have been Three mass operations, Cleft Care Indonesia was provide all necessary information to parents to assist their children before and after the surgery. We also provided them with spoon feeders and splint packages free.

Social workers and volunteers organized meetings with the families in the hospital some days before the

Surgery to explain what to do and not to do to assist their child, for example how to clean the wound, how to feed.

Usually for a cleft lip one day's recovery after surgery is enough; cleft palate children have to stay two to three days.
